Excessive absences will cause you to fall behind and possibly hurry to complete assignments, and/or turn in incomplete assignments. This will affect your grade.

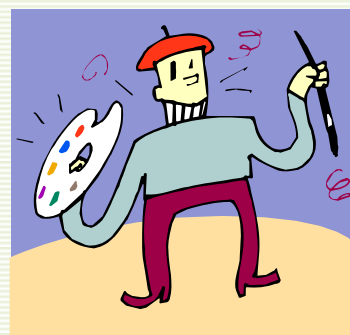
The Cost of Art!
